We are opposed to change of use to a dwelling house. We question whether the barn is no longer fit for purpose and also why the whole site is being included for change of use rather than a defined area around the barn. Relevant as the site is in the Green Belt and adjoins the Conservation Area.

There is a spring close to the site entrance and this together with possible increased water drainage from car parking may cause localised flooding.

The access onto Royston Lane is at a point of poor visibility of traffic from the south.
