EWR Railway Consultation: Full and Fair?

For the last six months Cambridge Approaches, supported by your village working group, has been asking EWR for a full and fair consultation on the routes for their proposed passenger and freight rail line.

The latest consultation was published on 31st March and is **neither full nor fair**.



EWR have ignored requests for a northern approach to be considered in parity with their preferred "Option E" area. Instead, the consultation document focuses exclusively on routes within the narrow Option E area, and reveals that for a 16km stretch from Caldecote Highfields to Harston, the line will be a great wall of continuous embankment, reaching a height of over 10 meters in some places and a base width of 50 meters or more. To give you an idea of scale, that would be higher and wider than the great wall of China.

A northern approach, such as the one proposed by think-tank CBRR. deserves due consideration and analysis. It passes 2 villages rather than 10, causes less damage to the environment according to the Wildlife Trust, and provides invaluable transport links to the growing settlements of Cambourne and Northstowe. CBRR also proposes that their line runs in a great trench, much narrower and passing under the A14, thus further reducing the environmental and residential impact. This approach is common practice in other places.

- Donate to fund the legal challenge Cambridge Approaches has taken appropriate legal advice and instructed a legal team to potentially challenge EWR by way of Judicial Review. The volunteers driving this campaign are ordinary, local people. A legal challenge costs money, and we have already raised initial funds from parish councils and private donors. But we only have a small window in which to challenge and must be able to demonstrate to a judge that funds are in place to be able to proceed. We aim to raise £50k from parish councils and a further £30K from concerned residents and currently need substantial donations from residents to hit this target.





However, Tsvety who manages our front of house, kindly took some time share some of our famous mouth-watering cake recipes... so we thought you might like to try them (although you may wish to visit the Bistro and sample them for first hand instead!)

Fruits of the Forest Brownie

Ingredients

135g frozen mixed berries 200g of quality milk chocolate 170g of salted butter 270g of soft dark brown sugar 4 medium size eggs 60g plain flour 35g cocoa powder

Method

- Heat the oven to 160 degrees C
- 2. Grease and line the tray with baking parchment
- 3. Gently melt the chocolate, butter and dark brown sugar in a saucepan
- 4. Stir every now and then and when it's all melted leave to cool
- 5. Once the mixture is cool, add one egg at a time and stir in
- 6. Once all the eggs are added, stir in the flour and cocoa powder
- 7. Pour the mixture into the baking tray and spread around
- 8. Sprinkle the frozen mixed berries evenly
- 9. Cook for 30 min or until a crust is formed

All adults across Cambridgeshire and Peterborough can now get free, regular, rapid coronavirus (COVID-19) tests/kits for home testing. One in three people with Covid don't have symptoms. So adults are being encouraged to take lateral flow tests twice a week - to stop outbreaks and keep the virus in check.

Oxford/Astra Zeneca vaccine safety review

After concerns about very rare blood clotting problems, the Medicines and Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency has carried out a review of the vaccine. It says the benefits continue to far outweigh the risks for people aged 30+ and those who have underlying health conditions. But healthy people aged 18-29 will now be offered alternatives for their first doses.
