

Discoveries..... or not?

Some of you will recall that in last month's Challenge the first question was "Who discovered Platinum?". This I now realise was an unanswerable question simply because of how we employ the word "discovered".

Whilst Julius Caesar Scaliger (1484/1558) was my target answer and very much supported by a large section of the scientific community a great deal of credit is rightly given to Antonio De Ulloa (1716/1795) who is also said to have discovered (identified) the element in question, but........

Whereas Scaliger can undoubtedly be given credit for announcing on the merits of platinum via the first written account of the metal in 1557 and De Ulloa is to be commended for his part in widening the knowledge of the element via the first paper describing the metal in 1736 neither can really given credit for its discovery, because.......

There is clear evidence that the metal had not only been mined long before, by not only the Ancient Egyptians (1200-700 BC) who used it in small quantities with gold for decorative objects but also by the Tolita Indians (600BC/200AD) living on the Ecuador/Colombia border who have been shown to have used the element . Could one say therefore that both Scaliger and De Ulloa simply spread the word, they did not discover the metal at all ?

On a similar theme but a different tack how should we view for example the voyages to the new world. Did Columbus really discover anything or did he merely visit a place details of which were not known on the European Continent? Had I been an inhabitant living close to his landing point in 1492 I would have regarded it as somewhat presumptuous for such a person to not only claim that he had discovered my country but then giving no thought to its name. Could it be said that Columbus merely "visited" the place? I must emphasise however that this is not to diminish for one moment the challenges he faced to make the voyage. This is also not to forget Amerigo Vespucci of course.

The same might also be said for David Livingstone who is credited with "discovering" the Victoria Falls during his travels across Africa . Discovering! Like Columbus he merely visited a place known to millions possibly over the preceding centuries, and assumed, wrongly in my opinion, that his visit gave him the right to both claim the Falls and to rename them. The indigenous peoples of the area would have been less than impressed had they known what was taking place. To them the site was , and remains to this day, Mosi-oa-Tunya (The Smoke That Thunders).

One final point to consider related to Crick and Watson's research culminating in the Nobel Prize in 1962 for their "discovery" of the Double Helix . Their work brilliant as it was was the culmination of efforts by many other scientists, in particular Rosalind Franklin, who received no recognition. Where long term , often multigroup/extended period research is concerned therefore the word "discovery " becomes even murkier. Discovery is rather like the 4x100 relay, the person breasting the tape might not be said to have won the race.




