Greetings Neighbours,

We have had a busy and enjoyable first half term of this academic year.

Both Y3 and Y4 have taken part in Team building days. Y4's activities included Stone Age orienteering and a Midnight crossing. Y3 enjoyed crossing the swamp and Detective squad amongst other activities. A number of children were able to join other schools from the South Cambridgeshire Partnership at CVC in an exciting Outdoor Adventurous Activity Challenge Event.

Our Meridian Fun Run had a route starting on the recreation ground and ending up on the school field. An amazing £187.53 was raised and this together with £50 donated from the Y6 Enterprising Day in July will be given to the Lisa Kent Trust to sponsor two children to pay for their school fees so they are able to access an education. The determination and resilience of all the runners was brilliant.

We held our annual Harvest Festival assembly in October with Reverend David Newton visiting us for a time of reflection for all the people who work in the food industry. 

Yew Trees Churchyards and Walls

Most people have a hazy memory of being told that yew trees in churchyards were used to make the Long Bow of England; famous for centuries as the most fearsome war weapon. So the story goes on that all parts of yew being so poisonous to cattle, the only place to keep these trees in order to equip the army, is in the churchyard because that has a wall around it which keeps the cattle out.



It's a good story but it doesn't hold up well to scrutiny. For many reasons. The English yew species is notorious for having gnarled and twisted branches compared with foreign species of yew, from which English bowyers could make better bows. This was reflected in the costs of using the foreign wood - a matter of about three times as expensive. One English tree at any one time might with luck produce four bows – enough maybe in a churchyard of several such trees to satisfy the local requirements of the community – but many British sovereigns down the centuries had to import yew staves from all over Europe and the East by the tens of thousand to satisfy the needs of their archers.

Furthermore many of these churchyard trees were thousands of years old, and another theory says that many churches were deliberately built on sites of earlier pagan religions where yew trees were worshipped. Certainly the Pope instructed St Augustin to do this as he introduced the Church to Britain. This would indicate many trees were there before the churches. This is but the tip of the iceberg of theories about yew trees in graveyards, but you get the drift.

And the walls? From their first building, the area around a church was usually enclosed by walls made from local material and the enclosure, often used for village activities from fairs to archery practice, also accommodated the graves of departed villagers, and was always a place of Sanctuary. It is estimated that there have to be many thousands of now-unidentified bodies in graveyards such as ours: bodies long since buried over with later interments. It is unsurprising that some churchyards are higher than their surroundings or that churchyard walls bulge outward under the pressure of bodies and the often excessive quantities of soil brought in to accommodate new burials.

The boundary walls of our churchyard are mainly flint and some parts are likely to have been in place many centuries. Over this time many repairs have been carried out and in places whole sections have been rebuilt. Currently there is serious deterioration in the western boundary, especially near the entrance to the north door. The Friends of St Mary's have underwritten the repointing and repair of this section of the wall which will commence at the end of this month.

In 1961, Kempton Bunton, a 60 year old taxi driver, stole Goya's portrait of the Duke of Wellington from the National Gallery in London. It was the first (and remains the only) theft in the Gallery's history.

Kempton sent ransom notes saying that he would return the painting on condition that the government invested more in care for the elderly - he had long campaigned for pensioners to receive free television.

What happened next became the stuff of legend. Only 50 years later did the full story emerge - Kempton had spun a web of lies. The only truth was that he was a good man, determined to change the world and save his marriage - how and why he used the Duke to achieve that is a wonderfully uplifting tale.

- Affiliated Community groups holding evening group social or fundraising events will be charged the residents evening rates. Non-affiliated groups holding similar events will be charged the non-residents evening rates.
- Groups working with children and/or vulnerable adults will need to have child protection and vulnerable adult policies & procedures in place.
- Annual affiliation fee of £10 is due on 1st January.


