Greetings Neighbours,

We have been pleased to be able to hold regular class assemblies to people from outside the school for the first time in over two years. It has been so lovely to see parents and carers visiting Meridian and we look forward to so many more during the academic year.

The children have also enjoyed being visited by people from outside the school – Y6 and Y4 benefitted from lessons from a Professor of Volcanology at the University of Cambridge and KS2 singing assemblies are now being led by the Lordsbridge Singing Project and children will have the opportunity to join community wide projects this year.

The aim of the Lordsbridge Singing Project is to enjoy singing out shared values and bring together the school and church community once each half term. Elements of vocal technique and musical understanding will be embedded into assemblies with aspects of the school's values also covered.

We held a special Remembrance Assembly focusing on all the animals that have helped servicemen and women in conflict and the children fundraised for the British Legion by buying poppies.

Our open morning at the end of November for prospective reception pupils was successful and well attended.

We welcome a new visiting teacher into school one afternoon a week to deliver lessons on the trumpet to Y4s. This is part of our music curriculum enrichment opportunities and free to access for all Y4 children. We are also pleased to welcome a new teacher into the school to teach violin to individual pupils.

Two Y6 Meridian netball teams attended a tournament at Comberton Village College and did really well which means they are both through to the next round which will be held in March. Selected children from Y3-6 took part in a cross country competition at the end of November.

We are pleased that we are now able to transport children from our families in Toft to school on the school bus that travels from the Eversdens. Although this is at an additional cost agreement with our coach provider, this solution is not only helpful to the families but friendly to the environment.

As part of our Anti-Bullying Week, we encouraged all our children to come to school in odd socks –this was a great way to encourage our children to respect our community, celebrate their individuality and uniqueness.

We have a number of events organised for December – a Santa Dash fun run, an EYFS/KS1 Nativity performance, KS2 Christmas Carol singing, a special Christmas lunch with Christmas jumpers, a School Carol service at St Mary's Comberton and busking in our playground with our musicians and choir.

We wish you all a very happy and safe Christmas, however you are celebrating.



Remembering your Faithful Friend this Christmas

Christmas may be a time to remember family and friends - but Dogs Trust Snetterton is also asking local dog owners to remember their four-legged friends this festive time, with a *Canine Care Card*.



The Canine Care Card is a free service, which helps to ensure your dog's future, in the event of you either passing away, receiving a life-changing diagnosis or moving into a care home. This can often be a great concern to some people, who perhaps do not have a family member or friend in a position to look after their dog, should the worst happen. Therefore, by signing up to the service, Dogs Trust can offer peace of mind, reassuring you that your faithful friend will be well cared for by the charity.

It is easy to sign up to the service, which simply asks for some information on your dog, including their likes and dislikes, as well as your dog's medical history and your vet details. It also asks for you to confirm who you would like as your Dog Guardian. This should be someone you trust, like a friend, family member, solicitor, neighbour or vet, who can sign over ownership of your dog to Dogs Trust on your behalf, should you become seriously ill or pass away.

You can register online by going to www.dogstrust.org.uk and searching for 'Canine Care Card' - or if you do not have access to the internet, you can request a paper version of the application form. Once the form is submitted, Dogs Trust will then write to you, to confirm when your application has been processed.

Once signed up, should your card ever need to be activated, Dogs Trust will then arrange with your Dog Guardian for your dog to come into the rehoming centre or into foster care. With a team of vets, trainers and behaviourists on hand if needed, your dog will then be welcomed, loved and well cared for by the charity, who will work tirelessly to find a loving new home for your much-loved canine companion.




