





## Pam goes East

As many of you will know, Pam Fisher has moved from Comberton to Beccles in Suffolk. What is written here is my personal reflection on Pam and her husband Don and also an acknowledgement of the huge contribution they have made to village life in Comberton.

Pam, Don and their two daughters came to Green Gables, Barton Road in 1968. The Meridian School had just been built and their younger daughter started on the first day it opened. Pam was a Doctor and involved with the Women's Institute as well as the Trefoil Guild (part of the Girlguiding family). She became District Commissioner and in 2021 was awarded the British Empire Medal.

Don was a Chemical Engineer, initially working in the steel Industry and later in power stations across Europe. Both Pam and Don were active supporters of St Mary's Church where Don was Treasurer and installed the heating and sound system. He was also involved with the new Village Hall and the church porch extension. Don was awarded the Etheldreda Medal in 2018 for generous and outstanding service to the community.

Pam and Don each had something of a rebel in them. Their life together began in Newport, Monmouthshire when the dentist they both attended cancelled their appointments and Don offered to take Pam home riding pillion on his motorbike. Later, when they were married Pam was one of only three doctors working in the old Addenbrooke's A&E department (now Brown's restaurant). While Pam was working as a GP visiting rural patients, Don would keep in contact using CB radio; Pam would reply from the nearest old fashioned phone box. Pam and Don also enjoyed camping, caravanning and gardening together, Don mowing not only their own lawn, but also their neighbour's.

Pam and Don's generous natures and a desire to do what is right, supported the community with respect, integrity and basic human kindness. All this was underpinned by their Christian faith.

Sadly, Don died in 2021 and Pam has moved to an "all singing and dancing" apartment close to one of her daughters. She now has a choice of four supermarkets and four churches to attend, WI and Trefoil to connect with, the River Waveney to enjoy, the Public Hall for meetings and theatre and a good bus service to Lowestoft and Norwich.

There is much more that could be written about them both, such as Don's boyish sense of humour and Pam's absolute professionalism as a GP, but It is impossible to encapsulate all this in just a few words. A couple of instances may go a little way though.



# **Comberton Antiquarians Society - Visit Norwich**

On 6 May 1682, a warship carrying the future King of England and Scotland ran aground in heavy seas off the coast of Great Yarmouth. Within an hour the vessel sank, causing many lives to be lost, and for over 300 years, the wreck and its contents lay buried on the seabed.

Now, this major exhibition will explore the ship's dramatic discovery by brothers Julian and Lincoln Barnwell, and display for the first time some of the fascinating objects recovered from the wrecksite. Most striking is the bell – that confirmed the ship's identity – which will be on show alongside beautifully preserved personal effects, that tell stories of the passengers and crew, and of life on board the ship.

The Society have organised a coach trip to this exhibition in Norwich on Saturday September 9th, leaving Comberton Village College at 9am and arriving back at 6pm.

The cost of the coach is £25 each and entry to the exhibition is £7 for seniors/concessions.


# **Update From The Trustees of Comberton Village Hall**

As the cost of living continue to increase for everyone the village hall has not been immune to the impact of these price rises on its outgoings. The trust has been subject to significant increases in the cost of electricity and heating oil as well as materials and labour when work is required to the fabric of the building and whilst many tasks around the hall are undertaken by a dedicated band of volunteers, there has also been an increase in wages for jobs which cannot be done by the unpaid trustees.

It has therefore regrettably become necessary to increase hire fees to help offset these increases so that the hall can continue to be the clean, warm and safe venue that we know is valued by so many in our community. The running costs have been examined in detail alongside predicted income and have been adjusted to a level which is felt necessary to help to reduce the otherwise inevitable shortfall whilst trying to minimise the impact on the people and groups who use it. The increase will be effective from 1st September 2023. As a Charitable Incorporated Organisation the trust does not set out to make a profit but merely to cover regular expenses as well as to build up a small reserve for the unavoidable medium term repair and replacement works which become necessary to the hall as a result of daily wear and tear and as the building ages. In the last couple of years, for example, we have replaced windows and doors, undertaken internal and external redecoration and replaced light fittings with energy saving alternatives, and are budgeting for future maintenance or replacement of essentials such as elements of the fabric of the building, the furniture, the heating system and projection equipment. The decision to raise hire fees has been a difficult but considered one and we can assure you that the increases have been kept to the minimum level necessary to continue to run this valuable community asset.

We would like to thank you for your understanding and continued support and look forward to continuing to welcome you to the village hall, which we believe still represents excellent value for money both in its own right and when compared to other local venues.
