

Comberton Parish Council meet each month on the second Wednesday of the month at 7.30pm in the Village Hall.





#### WILDLIFE MONITORING BY THE COUNTRYSIDE RESTORATION TRUST

Barton Village Hall, Monday 29<sup>th</sup> March. 6.30-9.30pm Since first acquiring a small field in Barton, back in 1994, the CRT has kept records of wildlife comings and goings as the area of Lark Rise Farm has expanded. Gradually, a living countryside has been restored and the farming has been made ever more wildlife-friendly. A substantial piece of land was acquired in 1998, making formal bird and butterfly monitoring on a large scale more realistic. A second large development came in 2001 with the purchase of Westfield Farm in Comberton. If conditions allow get out the mower and lightly cut the lawn. Make sure mower has been serviced and blade replaced or sharpened.

#### Fertiliser & Weed Control

This is the time to feed and weed (preferably in that order).

The fertiliser is predominately Nitrogen in a slow release form, but it may also need Phosphate and Potassium as well as vital trace elements. Once the weeds and grass are actively growing a selective herbicide to kill broad leaved weeds such as dandelions,

#### NEW BEGINNINGS

Ground temperatures should have started to rise after the hard winter. Plants spurt into growth when the ground warms to 6°C. Nevertheless, even in early February I saw two clouds of midges, freshly hatched, rising from the lawn and backlit by the low afternoon sun against a dark hedge. What surprised me was the fact that there were two species: large midges swirling round about 2 feet from the ground and a larger cloud of tiny midges bouncing up and down 3 feet above the larger midges. Alas I did not have my field guide to identify them. Mid-February saw the birds pairing up; male and female reed buntings that were coming to the seed feeder independently during the winter are now an item. The female blackcap warbler that had probably migrated here for the winter will be returning back to Germany in mid-March. Our resident male pheasant, even with his distinct limp, is followed about by a harem of females. With all these signs of an approaching spring, it is time to consider what would be good for the garden this year.

#### Hard work needed

The frozen ground has prevented many gardeners from doing very much and as a consequence very little gardening has been done. Weeding will be necessary to clear the ground before the spring flowers start to show. Pruning should also be done soon when the forecasts suggest a period free from frost. The key thing is to take stock and decide how you want your garden to look in the summer. The heavy frosts may well have killed tenderish plants and these will need to be replaced. There is still time to plant new shrubs and roses. Remember to add a good supply of garden compost into the planting hole and water in the plants.

#### Planting plan

The problem with many gardeners, who like myself are always buying new plants, is that they forget where the plants have been put and tend to overplant with new material.

Comberton Area Neighbourhood trends

Total crime across the Neighbourhood has remained stable compared to both the previous period and the same period last year.

Anti-social behaviour (ASB) incident levels have decreased compared to the previous period, but increased compared to the same period last year.

- 3. Emerging Issues
- 4. Comberton Ward (Comberton).
  - There were 13 offences in Comberton Ward in this period compared to 16 offences in the previous period and 7 offences in the same period last year.
  - There were 3 dwelling burglaries in this period compared to no offences in the previous period and 1 offence in the same period last year. The three offences occurred over a week long period in December and offenders forced either windows or doors to gain entry to the properties.
  - 'Theft from vehicle' offences have remained stable compared to the previous period (2 offences in each period) and compared to the same period last year (3 offences). In both offences the vehicles had been left insecure and items from within were stolen.
  - ASB incidents have decreased from 12 incidents in the previous period to 4 incidents in this period. Incident levels have remained stable compared to the same period last year when there were 5 incidents. There were no patterns or trends in the ASB incidents which occurred during this period.
